

Designate clean and dirty areas

When considering where to store supplies, equipment, etc., it is important to keep in mind “clean” and “dirty”. You should only store clean items in a clean room with other clean items. Never store clean items in a dirty room (For example, do not store clean equipment in a dirty utility room - you may use a dirty utility room to clean the equipment, but then store it in the clean utility room).

Always separate clean from dirty.

Mixed storage of clean and dirty: **BAD**



Separate clean and dirty spaces: **GOOD!**
