The resident or team member goes to a nearby public clinic 2. When there is a nearby public clinic, facility picks up the needed doses from the clinic site (or designated spots), assumes all liability for ensuring proper use and vaccination, and returns to facility to administer the shot. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. If this option is selected, the attached paperwork will need to be filled out. Please read this attachment for full details. b. Doses will only be relinquished to entities with NESIIS access or to nursing facility's that agree to fill out NCDHD forms and get a copy to NCDHD within 24 hours. <p>Residents or team members that missed their 2nd dose appointment or could not get their 2nd dose for any reason, please complete this survey: https://nalhd.sjc1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_0lk4KhN8mdtj3oi NCDHD will integrate them into a clinic as doses are available.</p> <p>***Please note NCDHD is not currently receiving Pfizer vaccine. Please still enter those that are due for a 2nd dose of Pfizer as NCDHD may be able to exchange Moderna doses for Pfizer doses with another Health Department. There's no timeline on this; however, it is important that the number of doses needed across the district is known.</p>
